

Fixed-Term Faculty Award for Excellence

Objective

The THCAS Fixed-Term Faculty Award for Excellence recognizes the sustained record of distinguished teaching, service, mentorship, and leadership by a fixed-term faculty member.

Award

One winner will be selected annually and will be allocated \$1000, which can be used for conferences/workshops, travel, materials/supplies, or other professional development expenses, in accordance with ECU spending regulations.

Eligibility

A nominee must:

- 1. be a current full-time (1.0 FTE) fixed-term faculty member at East Carolina University;
- 2. have been employed at East Carolina University for at least five years (which can include part-time employment);
- 3. have demonstrated exceptionally effective teaching, service, mentorship, and leadership during those five years.

Nomination procedures and guidelines

Departments may nominate one fixed-term faculty member per year. The department chair should submit the nomination packet <u>via Qualtrics</u> no later than 5pm on April 1 (or the next business day, if April 1 falls on a weekend).

Nomination packet contents

- 1. Nomination letter from department chair
- 2. Current CV
- 3. Up to 20 pages of supporting materials reflecting the nominee's teaching, service, mentorship, and leadership (such as syllabi, lesson plans, lecture slides, assignments, and other teaching materials; peer observations; service recognitions; etc.). Supporting materials may include links to digital artifacts such as Canvas modules and videos.
- 4. Optional: 2 additional letters of support from colleagues and/or students
